In response to the increase in air travel demand, Singapore Airlines (SIA) will be reinstating more flight services to key markets such as Japan, India, and to major cities such as Los Angeles and Paris. SIA will also continue to serve direct flights to Vancouver until March 2023. # SIA Operates its First Flights with Blended Sustainable Aviation Fuel in Singapore



In partnership with CAAS and GenZero, the SIA Group began the use of the neat fuel which is a blend of Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF) and Jet fuel into flights from 7 July 2022. This initiative will cut the total carbon dioxide emissions by 2,500 tonnes thus
