

Extend your Qantas status for 12 months with just one flight.



Since March 2020, Qantas has offered members a range of support options to retain their tier including status extensions, Status Credit boosts and the ability to earn them on the ground. They are now extending that support even further.

With just 1 flight, eligible members could benefit from an extra year of status and a Status Credit rollover.

Status Extension

Qantas will extend the status for Qantas Frequent Flyer members who reside in Australia or New Zealand who:

- hold Platinum One, Platinum, Gold or Silver status and have not been able to earn the required Status Credits to retain their status;
- have an upcoming status end date before, and including 31 December 2022; and
- have made a new booking to travel on at least one eligible flight for travel any time before 31 December 2022. For members with a status end date before 30 June 2022, the booking creation date must be between 11 August 2021 and before the member's current status end date. For members with a status end date between 31 July to 31 December 2022 the booking creation must be between 28 February 2022 and before the member's status end date.

Members who have received complimentary Gold status, or complimentary Platinum from a Platinum One member and those on Status Hold are eligible to have their status extended if they meet the above criteria.

Status Credit Rollover

Qantas will rollover eligible Status Credits earned, up to a cap of at least 40% of the Status Credits required to retain a member's status. Customers must meet the criteria to be eligible.
